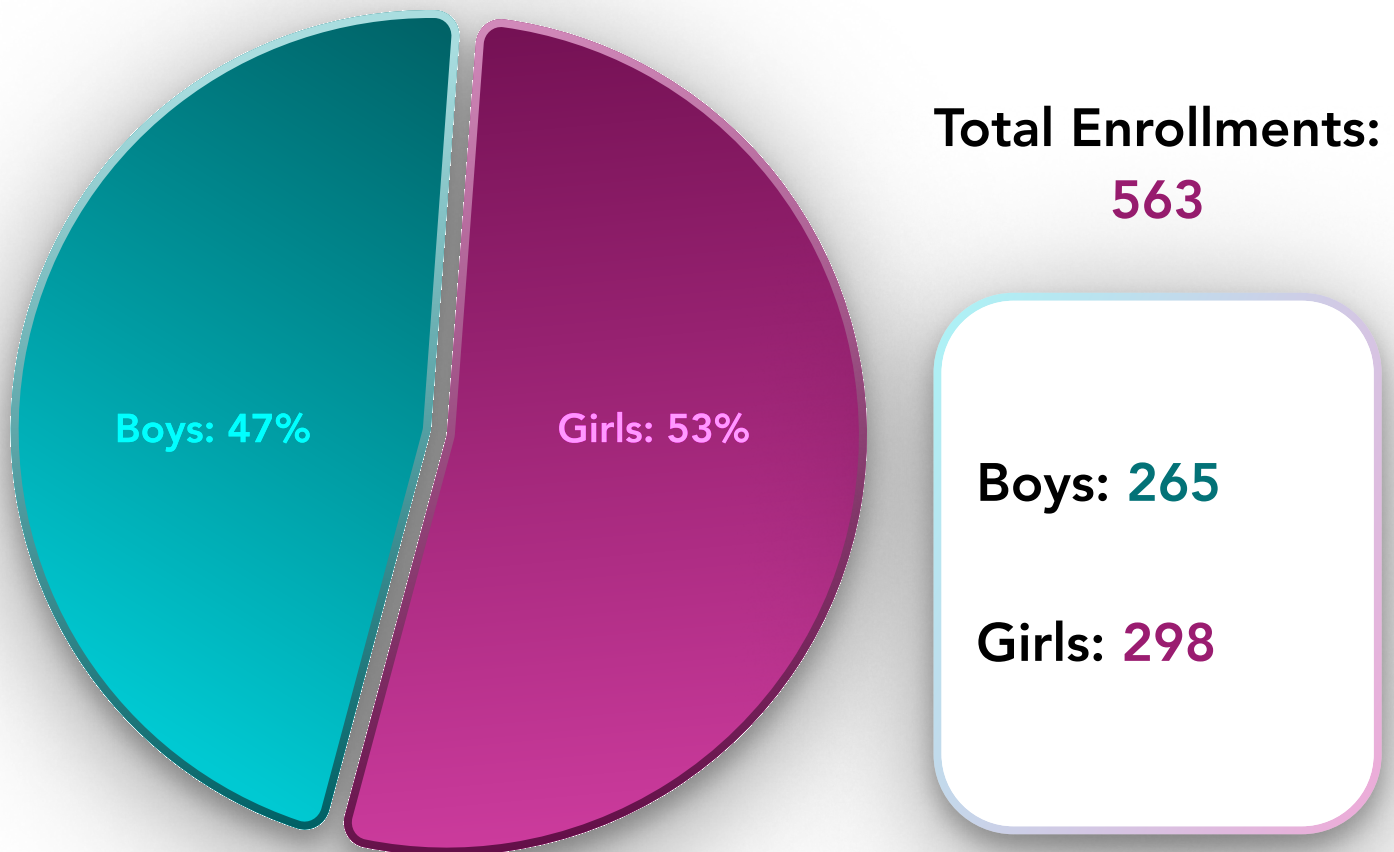
IQRA College is renowned for its successful focus on the well-being of their students and staff.

We maintain a high staff retention rate while also welcoming new faces each year, reflecting the school's growth and continued success.

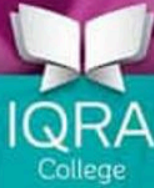
NAPLAN Results

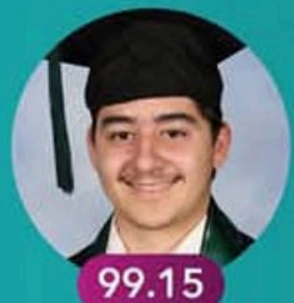

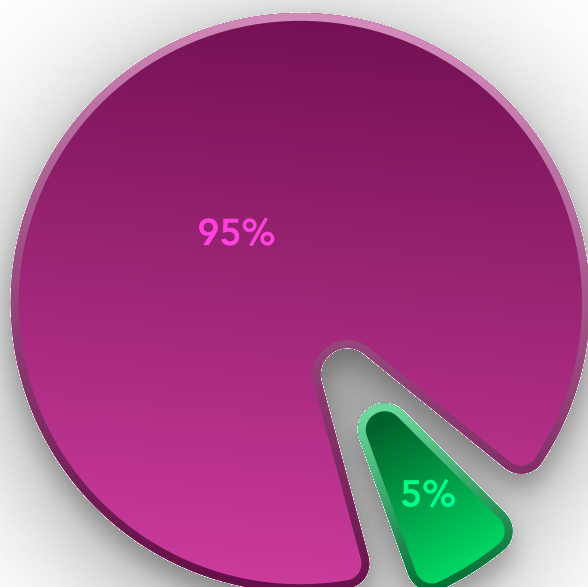
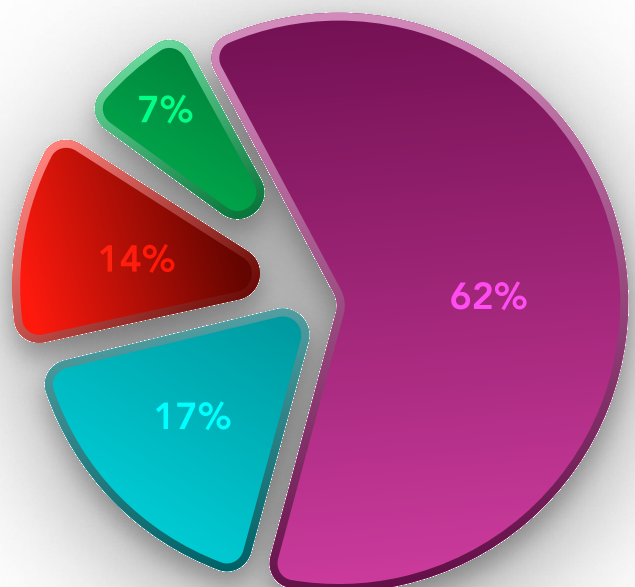
